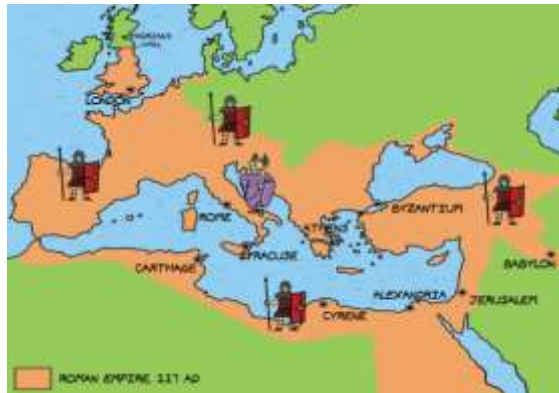


Key facts-

Soldier	A person who serves in an army.
Toga	A loose flowing outer garment worn by the citizens of ancient Rome.
Mosaic	A picture or pattern produced by arranging together small pieces of stone, tiles or glass.
Empire	An extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single monarch.
Mythology	A collection of myths, especially one belonging to a particular religious or cultural tradition.
Colosseum	The name of the amphitheatre in Rome.



Important names-

Julius Caesar – Attempted to invade England twice. He was only leader for one year before being assassinated.



Emperor Claudius – Lead the third attempt to invade Britain and ruled from 41 AD to 54 AD.

Hadrian- A Roman Emperor who built a wall to protect Britain against attacks.

Queen Boudicca- Queen of the Celts at the time of the third Roman invasion. She formed an army to attack the Romans in AD61.



Augustus – The first Roman Emperor, he established the Roman Empire.
