### Reopening of School

Thank you to all of you for completing the survey sent out last week. The information we received from you has been crucial in our planning and preparation for the next couple of weeks. Please note that all of our plans are totally dependent on a number of factors:

- ✓ The agreement of the Multi-Academy Trust Board of Directors to our plans
- ✓ The publication and scrutiny of the SAGE medical advice on the return of pupils to school (due later today)
- ✓ The government's planned announcement next Thursday on whether we may proceed
- ✓ The availability of staff to meet demand.

It is **not likely** that all groups of eligible pupils will be able to return immediately on 1<sup>st</sup> June.
