Parking

Covid safety

Please can we remind parents and carers that we have a healthy lunchbox policy in school and that it is not appropriate to send fast food style lunches for your children.

Arrangements for the end of Year 6

With lots still unknown about the coming few months, we have made some plans for our Y6 pupils, to help them get the most out of their last few weeks in school.

The Year 5 and 6 classes will be taking part in Theatre Week from 19th-23rd July, where they will work with the Young Theatre Company at the Acorn Theatre for the whole week. This will culminate in the performance of a musical at the theatre on the afternoon and evening of 23rd July.
