## Positive Covid Tests

Numbers of positive covid tests have more than doubled in Bassetlaw in the last week. We are seeing a steep rise in cases across the district, particularly in young adults and it is once again becoming likely that this will cause disruption to class bubbles in the coming weeks. Please be reminded that work will be set for a class to complete at home, should they be required to self-isolate and it can be accessed from the class blogs.

National data is clear that the vaccination programme is having a strong impact.
